### General Rules

\*This is a prospect market lamb and goat jackpot show open to any 4-H and FFA member between the ages of 7-21 as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.

\*Exhibitors shall at all times conduct themselves with honesty and good sportsmanship and reflect the highest standards of honor and dignity to promote the advancement of agricultural education.

\*Exhibitors are required to present and care for animals in a humane and ethical manner.

### General Sheep and Goat Rules

1. All market animals must be slick shorn full pelt before they are eligible for check-in.
2. Humane handling practices of sheep/goats are required at all times.
3. Generators are allowed and recommended due to limited power.
4. With limited space, showman are welcome to show off trailers.
5. Bedding will not be provided at the show.
6. Health Requirements- sheep or goats with clinical signs of infectious, contagious, or toxicological disease will not be permitted to show and should not be unloaded at the show site. In addition, because of the USDA requirements for intra and/or interstate movement of sheep or goats, all sheep or goats must have official USDA identification (ID) ear tags. Animals without proper identification are not eligible to show.
7. All MCLA & MBGA rules apply.

### Market Lamb and Goat Preview

1. Classes will be determined by weight on the day of the show. Classes will be divided with approximately equal numbers per class. All black face sheep will be shown together with a minimum of one white face class being offered. (Sheep weights will be used for both sheep rings.)
2. We will not offer a market ewe lamb class but will allow ewes to show with wethers by weight.
3. First and second place animals in each class will be brought back to determine the division grand and reserve champions. The division grand and reserve champions will then be brought back for the overall champion and reserve placing. (Divisions are subject to change)
4. We will pick a Top Five for both sheep rings as well as the goat show.

### Commercial Ewe Division

1. Ewes will be shown by weight.
2. Ewes born on or after September 1, 2015 are eligible to show. Yearling ewes and ewe lambs will be shown separately. An overall champion and reserve champion ewe will be selected.

### Educational Contest

1. The educational contest will be provided and run by a representative from MCLA. Please see MCLA website for rules and regulations on the educational contest.

### Late Entry

Any entry forms postmarked after May 6th, 2017 will be expected to pay late entry. Late Fees will be \$30/head.
