## SHOW ORDER

- Rings 1 and 2 will run at the same time. Sheep will start at 10:00 in ring 1 and goats will start 10:30 a.m. in ring 2. **Exhibitors are required to show in Show A to Show B.**
- Goat show B will start in ring 1 15 minutes after the conclusion of sheep show A in ring 1. Sheep show B will start in ring 2 15 minutes after the conclusion of sheep show A in ring 1.
- There will only be one showmanship per species. Goat Showmanship will be in ring 1 and show youngest to oldest. Sheep showmanship will be in ring 2 and show oldest to youngest.

## REGULATIONS

- Open to any youth that have reached their 7<sup>th</sup> birthday and are not yet 22 as of January 1 of the current year. Out of state exhibitors must have health papers to present at check in.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal, unless an exhibitor has two in the same class or if an exhibitor has another animal showing in the other ring.
- No limit on the number of entries per exhibitor. However, only two premiums will be paid per exhibitor per class.
- All sheep and goats must remain inside the MSU Pavilion once they are checked in. No showing off trailers.
- Exhibitors must use only pens that are assigned for use at the MJLS Summer Spectacular.
- Pens must be bedded with natural bedding (wood shavings, straw, etc...). No carpet.
- Pens must be cleaned out before leaving the pavilion.
- All market lambs must be slick shorn within 5 days prior to weigh-in.
- Muzzles are prohibited.
- When lambs are braced and/or shown on the profile they must have all 4 feet on the ground. No slapping will be tolerated.
- Sheep and/or goats with clinical signs of infectious, contagious, or toxicological disease will not be permitted to show and should not be unloaded at the show site. In addition, because of the USDA requirements for inter and or intrastate movement of sheep, the MJLS Summer Spectacular will require that all sheep and/or goats must have official USDA identification (ID) ear tags.
- Animals with visible prolapses are not allowed to exhibit.
- Exhibitors shall always conduct themselves with honesty and good sportsmanship and reflect the highest standards of honor and dignity to promote the advancement of agricultural education. Humane and ethical care and handling practices of sheep is always required.
- The Michigan Junior Livestock Society (MJLS), MCLA, MCGA, MSBA and/or MSU Pavilion are not responsible for accidents or lost/stolen items.
- All MCLA and MCGA rules apply.
- All University rules and policies apply at the pavilion.

## EWES

- All breeds of sheep are eligible to show.
- Ewes born on or after September 1, 2023, are eligible to show. Ewe will be shown as yearling ewes if born on or after September 1, 2022, thru August 31, 2023. Ewe lamb classes will be those ewes born on or after September 1, 2023.
- There will be a white face ewe division, and black face ewe division.

## SHOWMANSHIP

- Classes will be divided by age of exhibitor. Please include the exhibitor's date of birth as of January 1 of the current year on the entry form.
- Only youth that enter and exhibit their own animal in the show may participate.

- Youth must show their own animal in showmanship.
- Age divisions are: Beginner 7-11, Junior 12-14, Intermediate 15-17, Senior 18-21

## MARKET LAMB

- Open to wether or ewe lambs.
- Lambs with testicles or yearling teeth will be disqualified.
- Classes will be determined by weight on the day of the show. Classes will be divided with approximately equal numbers per class. There will be five division champions and reserves. Division one will be white face and divisions two through five will be black face.
- All Suffolk, Hampshire, Oxford, Shropshire, Natural Colored and black-faced crossbreds will show together by weight. There will be a minimum of four black face divisions. All white faced, speckles, southdowns, dorsets, white face cross, and other white face breeds will show together by weight in a separate division.

## MARKET GOAT AND COMMERCIAL DOES

- Open to wether or doe Boer Goats.
- Market Goats have to be slick shorn.
- Commercial does can be shown slick or haired. Slick and hair commercial does will show together by weight. If a commercial doe is shown in the market goat show it must be slick shorn.
- Commercial Does will show in their own classes and divisions. Commercial does will not compete for the top 5 overall market goats. Top three overall Commercial does will be chosen. Commercial Does can show in both the market goat and commercial doe division. Exhibitors must pay entry fees for both divisions if they wish to show the doe in the market doe and market goat division.
- Goats without milk teeth will be disqualified.
- Classes will be determined by weight on the day of the show. Goats will weigh in at the same time as sheep. Classes will be divided with approximately equal numbers per class.
- Weight class winners will be brought back to determine the champion and reserve division. The champion and reserve divisions will then be brought back for top 5 market goats. All class first and seconds in the commercial doe show will be brought back for top 3 commercial doe.

There will be a multiple choice test on general knowledge of sheep or goats and their industry. Topics may include, but not limited to nutrition, management, health, reproduction, genetics, fitting and showing, selection and meat products. \*\*\*\*\*NOTE\*\*\*\*\* MCLA Sheep quiz is only offered at 9am.
